## DISCOVER MY HOUSE

You've just joined one of the 43 houses on campus. Welcome! Each house has its own director. It also has a professional team who will ensure that your stay goes smoothly.

#### COMMUNAL AREAS TO ENCOURAGE EXCHANGES

Each house has communal areas to encourage meetings and collective living. There are 15-70 different nationalities in each house, allowing you to live in a multicultural and international environment that encourages exchanges and creativity.



In order to encourage exchanges, a mixing principle, which is written into general rule, requires each house to welcome at least 30% of residents of other nationalities.



#### PARTICIPATE IN BRINGING YOUR HOUSE TO LIFE

The campus is yours, so take part in organising its social and cultural life! Every year residents are elected to bring the campus to life and represent residents in front of the administration.

#### The Residents' Committees

Representing residents, bringing your house and campus to life, setting up collective projects... That's the role of the Residents' Committees. Each house has its own committee, which is elected at the start of the year, and which is responsible for residents' initiatives at the house and campus levels.

#### **Residents' Bureau**

Every committee selects two delegates to sit on the Residents' Bureau. These delegates represent residents' interests, organise numerous events and get involved in the Fête de la Cité. Two elected representatives sit on the board of directors for the National Foundation Cité internationale universitaire de Paris.

#### **YOUR RESIDENT** CARD

Your resident card is proof of your status. Always keep it with you to prove your resident status. You can download it in the Residents' Portal.

### **A SAFE** CAMPUS

#### The campus has a security desk at 27 Boulevard Jourdan

Security guards are present 24/7 to ensure residents' safety and to monitor the park. houses and campus spaces. For your security, the park has CCTV and houses are equipped with fire extinguishers and defibrillators

#### In the park



- Consumption of strong alcohol and drugs is forbidden.
- Avoid walking alone in badly lit areas at night.
- The park is closed to non-residents after 9:30pm.

#### In your house

- Do not let any unknown persons enter with vou.
- Always close your bedroom door and windows when you leave.
- Smoking is prohibited.
- Installing cooking plates and highenergy or non-compliant electrical appliances is forbidden.

#### **Listening unit**

Depending on both the situation and the victim's agreement a listening unit can be set up to hear the victim and take stock of the situation. Victims are supported throughout the process (social support, psychological support, medical consultations, referral to legal aid, etc.).

#### **Investigation unit**

For serious offences a disciplinary investigation is carried out confidentially and impartially. According to the situation a disciplinary sanction may be imposed, which may include exclusion.



### CHARTER TO ANCHOR CAMPUS VALUES

The Cité internationale places solidarity and humanist values at the heart of its commitments. In 2022 a Charter of values was created and signed by all of the houses at the Cité internationale. It is displayed in each house.

## **BEECO-**FRIENDLY

Faced with the ecological crisis, the Cité internationale is taking action toward a sustainable world by being at the forefront of the fight against climate change.

In 2009, all pesticides were banned and in 2014 a sustainable development strategy was adopted with an ecocampus charter. This strategy has three main bases: to protect, preserve and enhance our green spaces, to improve waste management and to reduce our energy consumption. Concrete measures promote eco-friendly behaviour, support the collaborative and circular economy, encourage biodiversity in Paris and integrate planetary limits into our activities.

In order to reduce our waste, improve our energy consumption, avoid wasting resources and further reduce our greenhouse gas emissions, everyone needs to change their daily habits and consumption.

### Protecting the park and its biodiversity

The second biggest park in Paris, the Cité internationale is one of Southern Paris' green lungs. This exceptional landscape, which is home to more than 400 different plant species, is a popular relaxing and leisure space for residents, Parisians and those living in Île-de-France. The Cité internationale is a pioneer in Paris and since 2009 has sustainably managed its spaces in order to fight against climate change and promote biodiversity. The gardeners have adopted a reasoned approach to maintaining the park.

The increased number of visits to the site over the last 10 years and the increased harmful behaviour have significantly weakened our flora and certain trees and shrubs are failing. This weakness compromises the development of biodiversity and calls into question the park's original aspects.

All residents of the park are invited to respect this biodiversity!



#### Adopt selective sorting

The park and its kitchens are equipped with selective sorting bins and 8 composting sites to allow residents to sort their green waste. Ask your house for information on sorting rules.

#### **Reduce energy consumption**

In 2022, a plan to reduce energy consumption was adopted to respond to the energy crisis and the climate emergency. Adopt good habits to limit your consumption of water and energy and preserve resources.

# **RESEARCH AND**

In a prestigious and welcoming environment, the main library provides work spaces and collections covering all disciplines.

> It is open 7 days a week from Monday to Friday from 10am-10pm and on the weekend from 1pm-7pm on the second floor on the Maison internationale.

#### MULTIDISCIPLINARY COLLECTIONS

Collections are primarily oriented toward Master's students and researchers There are:

50,000 physical works available for on-site use



9800 periodicals available for on-site use

378.000 digital books.

63 databases (journals, articles, scientific works, raw data, news, etc.) are available on-site and in the houses via the digital network: Cairn.info, Dalloz, Lextenso, SpringerNature, British Medical Journal, Nature, Oxford University Press. etc.

The Cité internationale, in partnership with the CNAM, is offering a series of specialised courses designed to help you discover French and European political, scientific and cultural life through courses, workshops, lectures and visits.

#### A SUBSCRIPTION FOR EVERYONE

There are two options to choose from:

Free Actisport programme: choose from a range of different activities that you can do by yourself at your own pace.

#### Supervised Actisport programme: choose from a range of different activities supervised by a professional.

#### INTER-FOUNDATION GAMES

Throughout the academic year there are inter-foundation games, allowing residents to defend their house colours in different activities: table tennis, tennis, volleyball, football, basketball, futsal and badminton.

On campus you can play 60 sports either on your own or with a group, choose yours!



#### FREE ACCESS FACILITIES

If you don't want to join a sports club, you can still freely practise sports in the park. Free access facilities allow you to play boules, football and basketball. A free access crossfit area is also located by the west stadium in front of the Pavillon Habib Bourguiba.



Included in the offers, or available à la carte, the tournaments are played ad hoc (leisure tournaments) or regularly throughout the year. Inter-foundation games allow residents of the houses to compete in tournaments.

## A MAJOR ARCHITECTURAL SITE

The Cité internationale has an exceptional architectural heritage with 43 houses built since 1925.

Built by renowned architects, the houses offer a diversity of styles that are unique to Paris. From Foujita to Jacobsen and Perriand, many of the works were also created by famous painters, sculptors and designers.

To discover the Cité internationale's history, architecture, missions and development, head to the Maison internationale in the Heritage Centre.

As a group or individually, take part in guided tours all year round to discover the architectural, artistic and landscape heritage of the Cité internationale.

Six campus houses are classed as historic monuments.

### Cité 2025: 10 new houses and modernised services

The Cité internationale is currently undergoing a historic development phase. 10 new houses will be built by 2025 and the entirety of its services will be modernised according to the Cité numérique plan. Two new country houses will open their doors: the Maison d'Égypte (October 2023) and the Maison de Chine (January 2024). The Fondation Avicenne will reopen after undergoing a major refurbishment in January 2024.

#### **Energy renovation**

The Cité internationale benefits from financial support from the State and the European Union as part of the Recovery Plan for energy renovation. Five houses on campus are concerned: the Fondation Avicenne, the Fondation Deutsch de la Meurthe, the Fondation de Monaco, the Maison des étudiants arméniens and the Maison des Provinces de France. End of work in the summer of 2024.



Free guided tours for residents are organized all year round.
